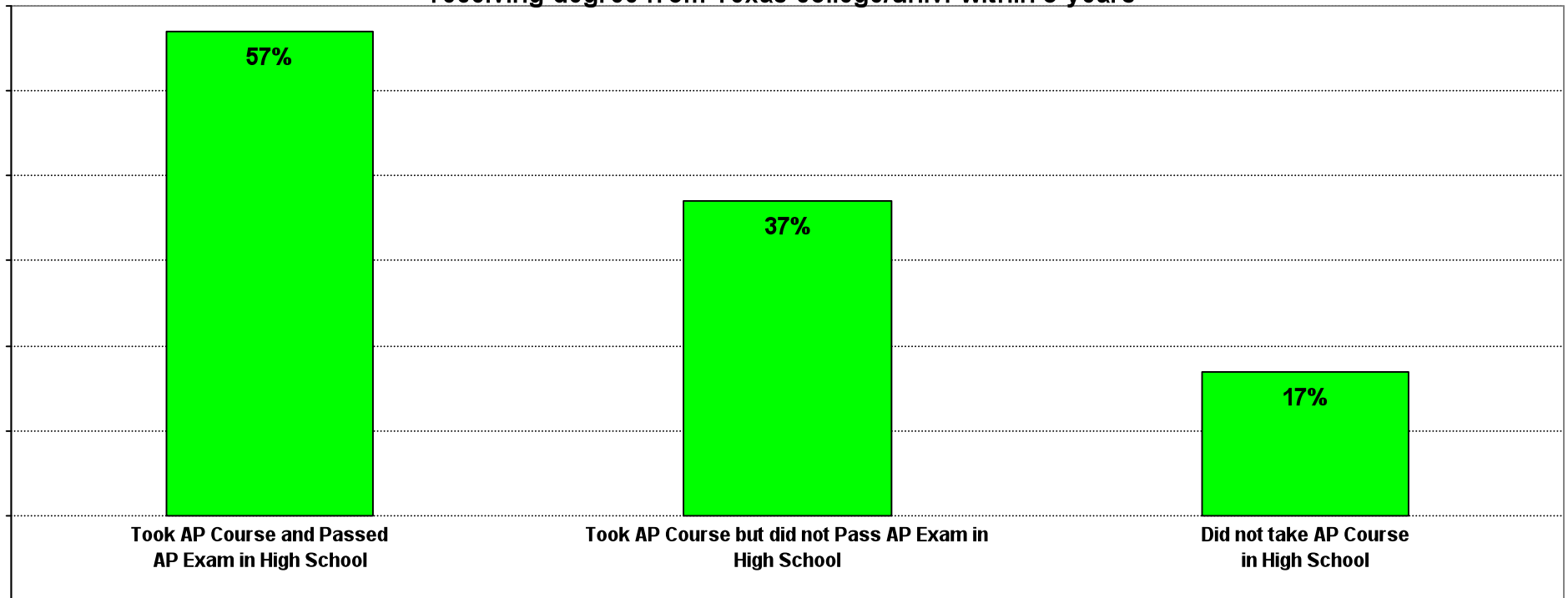
AP Effect

- Better prepared academically for college
- More likely to specialize in majors with tougher grading standards
- More likely to complete college course work
- More likely to take subjects in their AP subject area
- Likely to perform significantly better over four years of college course work
- More likely to be superior in terms of leadership
- More likely to make significant accomplishments in college
- Twice as likely to do graduate level studies

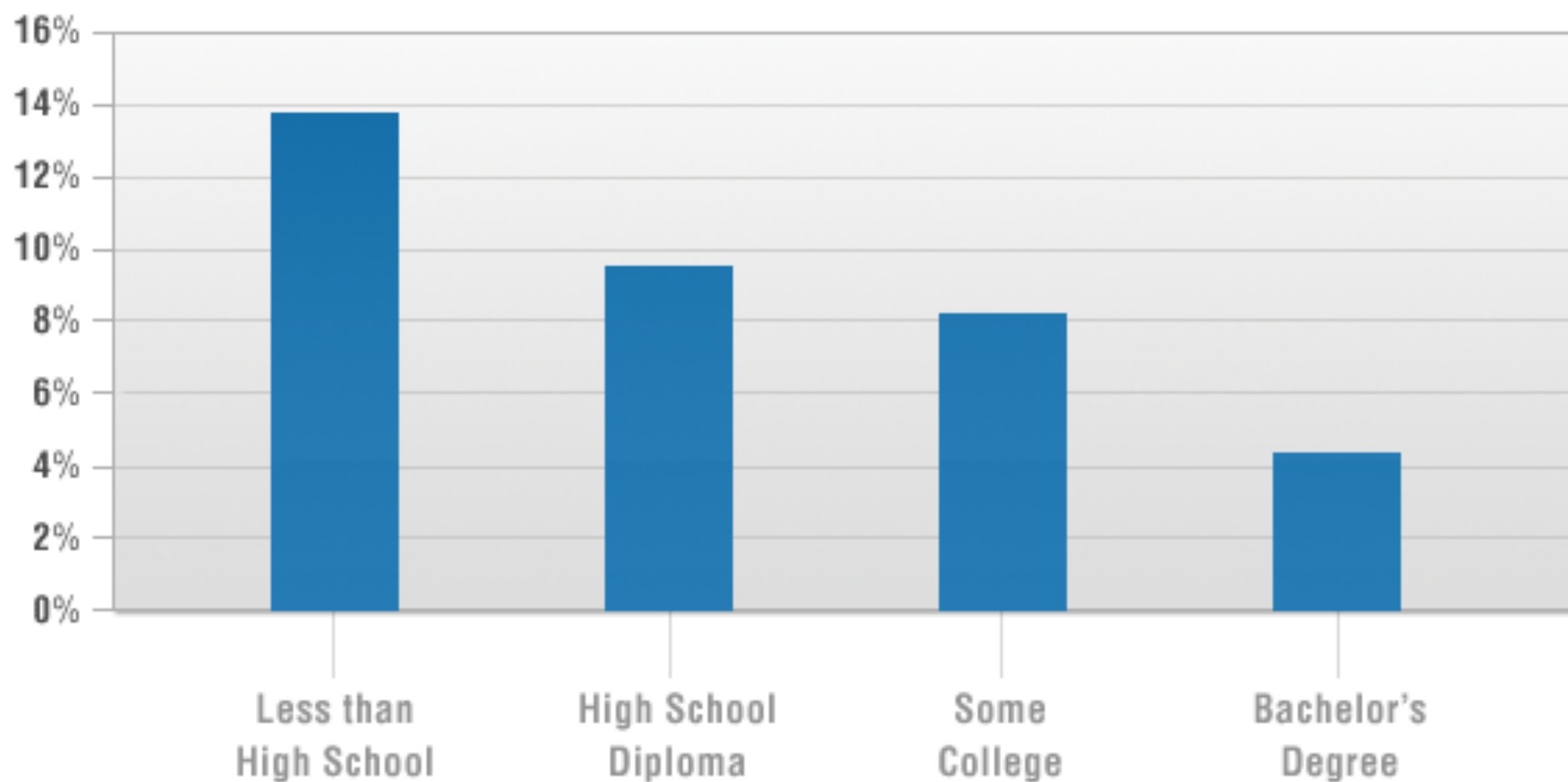


Why Take AP?

Unemployment Rate by Education Level



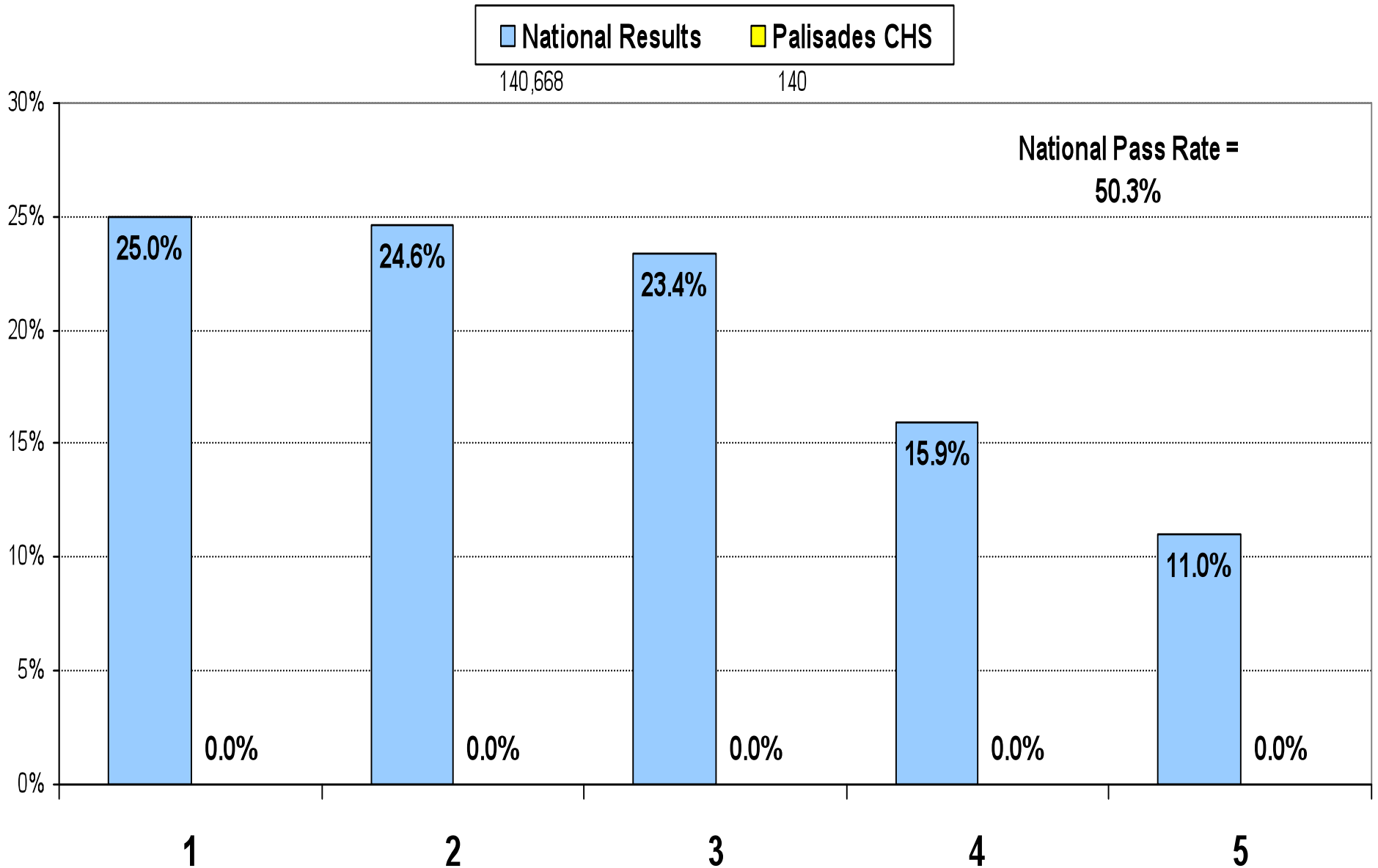


What do AP Exam scores represent?

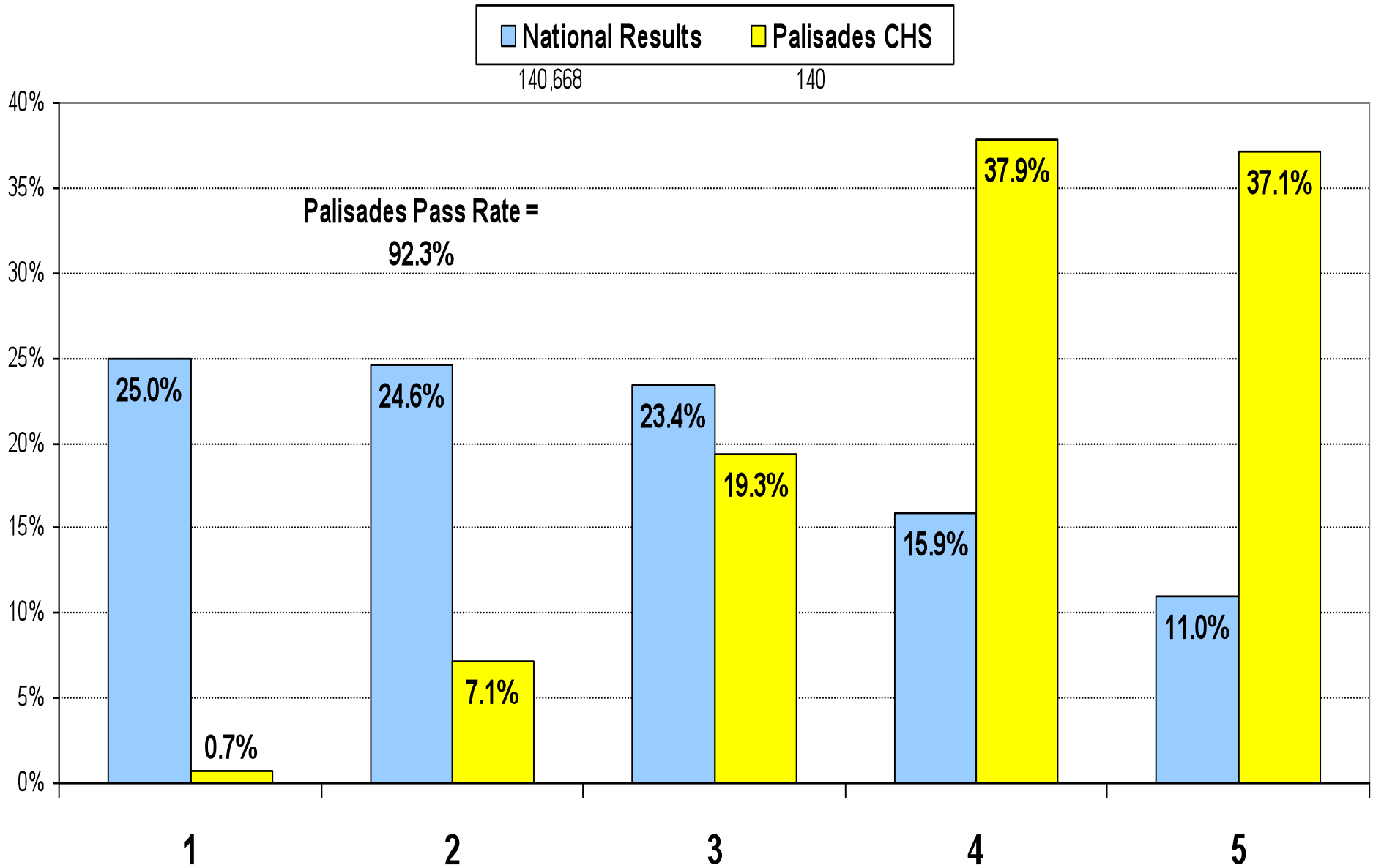
The number of points a student earns across the 3 ½ 4 -hour AP Exam is converted into a final AP Exam score of 1, 2, 3, 4 or 5:

AP Score	Corresponding College Grades
5	A
4	A-, B+, B
3	B-, C+, C

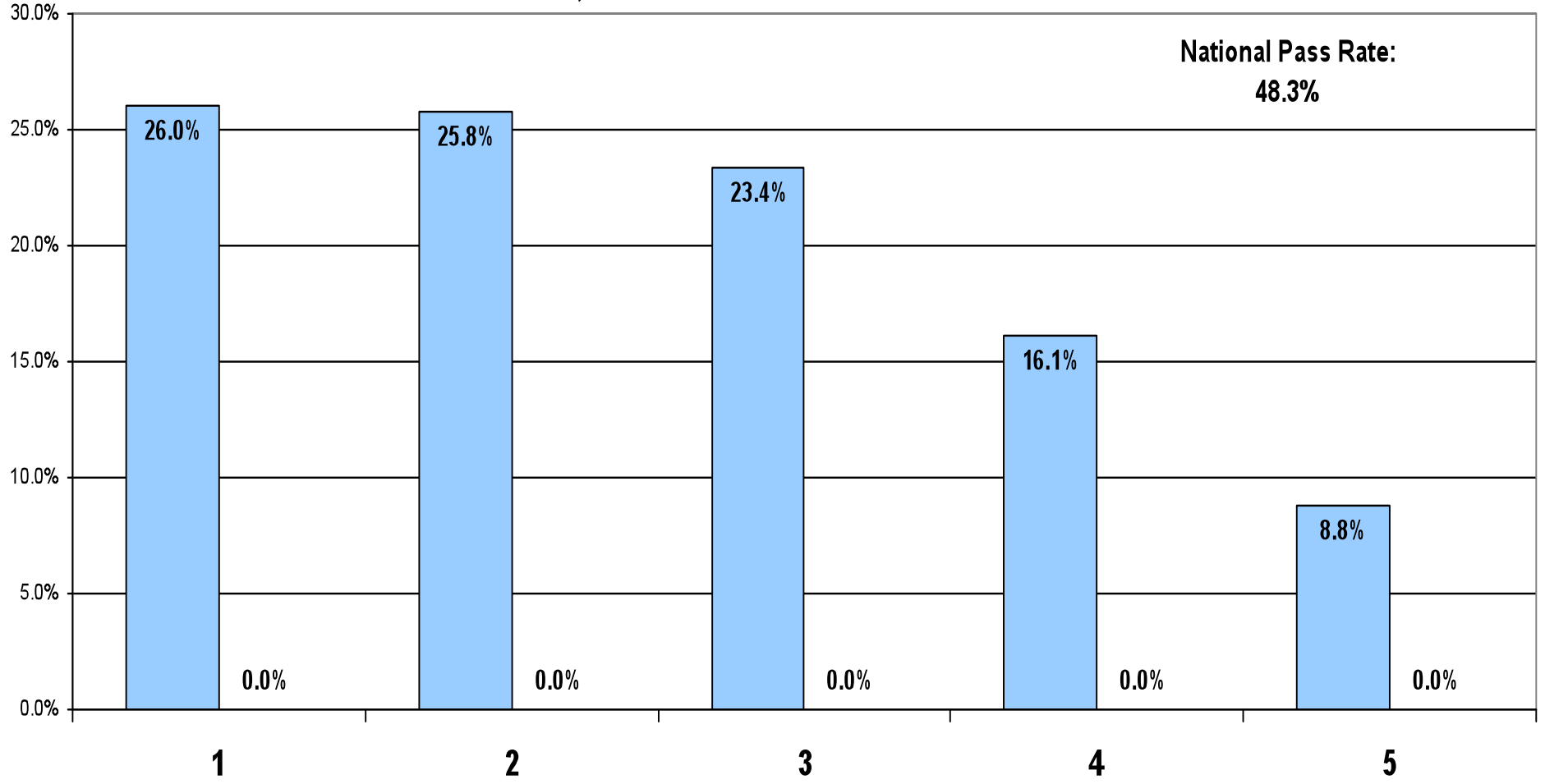

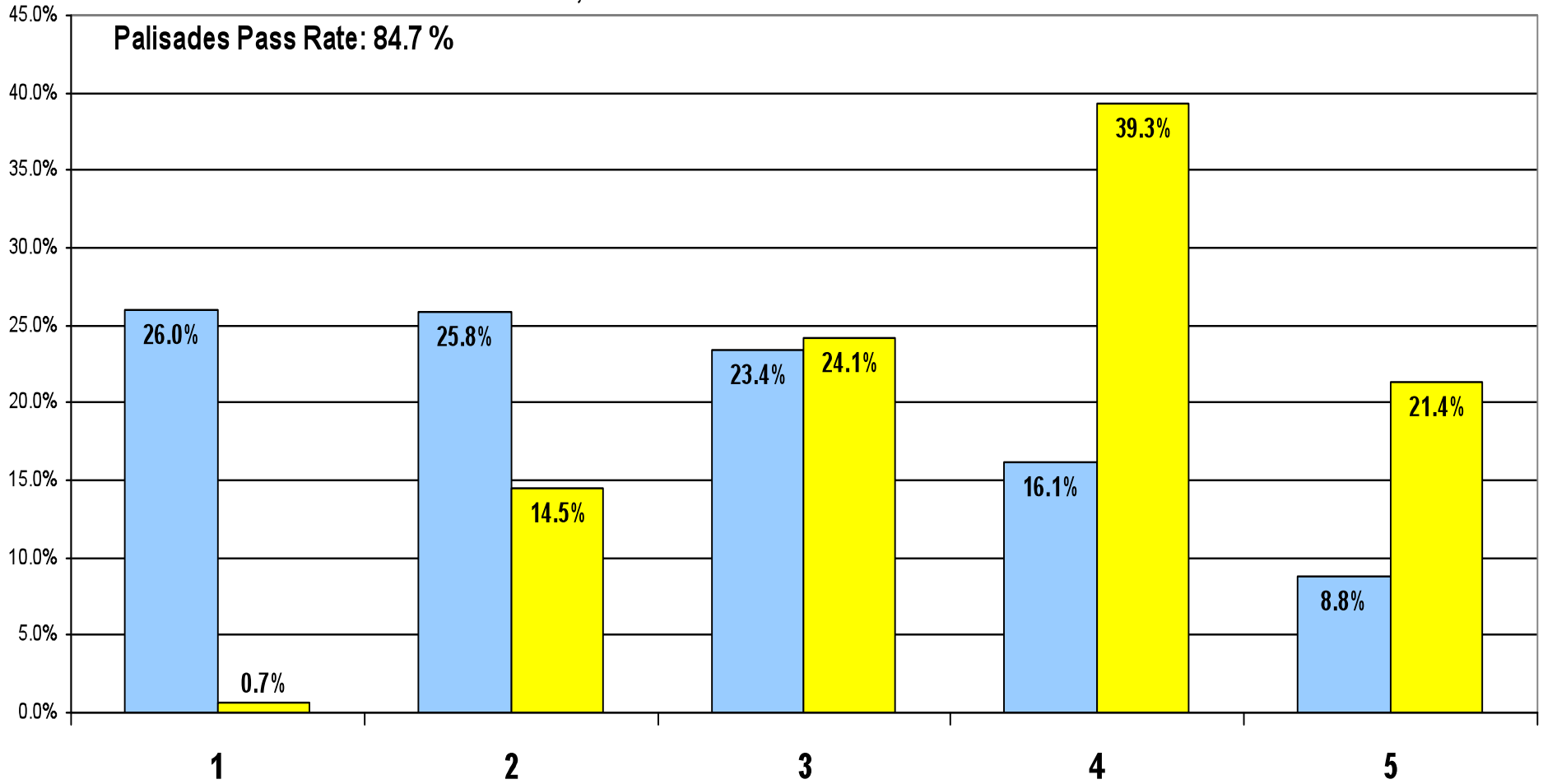
