Why is it important to meet a-g requirements?

The Subject Requirement, known more commonly as the "a-g" subject requirements, is one of three requirements needed to enter a UC or CSU as a freshman.

(The other two required parts for UC/CSU admission are: ACT or SAT test results and Grade Point Average.)

What are the a-g requirements?

Grades of "C" or better must be earned in all a-g courses!

- a History / Social Science 2 years required
 - b English 4 years required
 - c Mathematics 3 years required,
 - 4 years recommended
 - d Laboratory Science 2 years required,
 - 3 years recommended
 - e Language Other than English -
 - 2 years required, 3 years recommended f Visual & Performing Arts
 - 1 year-long course required
