## Circle Lesson for Task Force Retreat Tuesday, November 5th, 2014

1. Opening: Thank you for coming together to learn more about RJ practices, do important work and learn about one another.

Openings can be a poem, quote, guided mediation, breathing exercises, song, chant...

"The Sharing of joy, whether physical, emotional, psychic, or intellectual forms a bridge between the sharers which can be the basis for understanding much of what is not shared between them, and lessens the threat of their difference."

- 2. Introduction of talking pieces: purpose is to create an equitable environment for sharing, everyone gets a chance to speak or have the right to pass.
- 3. Check-In: Name...and If you could be a weather pattern, what pattern would describe how you are feeling right now (today)?
- 4. Values/Guidelines: Reminder that we want to bring our "best selves" to the discussion...repect, honesty, trustworthiness, courage...GUIDELINES: Here are the core circle guidelines. Are there any other guidelines you want to add? Pass talking piece...
- 5. Discussion Rounds: How do you think circles are being used at our school now? In what other capacities could they be used? What are your needs with facilitating community building circles?
- 6. Check-out: Share one word about how you are feeling at the end of circle
- 7. Closing: clap, poem, quote, song, breathing exercise.
