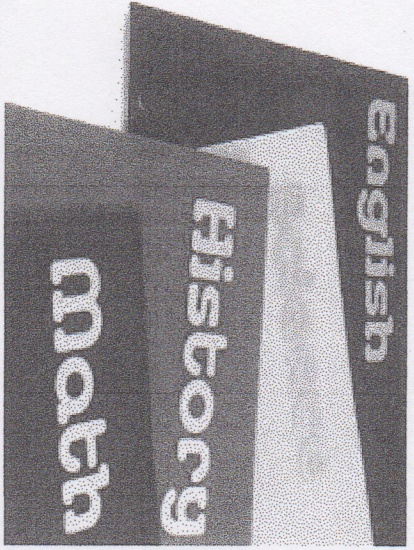
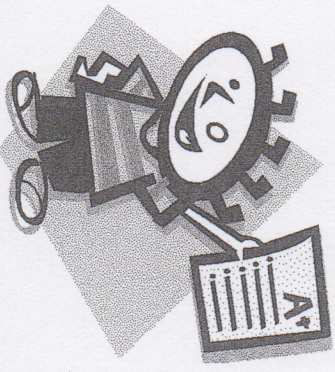

How do I input my grades onto MiSiS?

Log in to MiSiS.	Log in to MiSiS.	Log in to MiSiS.
Click on Admin tab (gray section on top right hand corner).	Click on Students tab (gray section on top right hand corner).	Click on Reports tab (gray section on top right hand corner).
In the drop down box, highlight and click on "Grades by Class".	For whatever student you are grading, click on the white box called "Action".	In left hand menu, scroll down to "Grades" heading.
Go to right hand column, click on "View Grades" for whatever subject you're inputting grades for.	A drop down menu will appear. Highlight and click on "Grades".	Click on "Teacher Verification of Marks - Elem".
In top left hand corner, click on "Edit".	Scroll all the way down, and click on "View Grades".	Select "Campus" drop down menu. Click on "5 ^{2ND} ST EL - 3808".
Input your achievement (AC) and effort (EF) grade for each student in that subject.	At the bottom, click "Edit" button.	Select "School(s)" drop down menu. Click on "5 ^{2ND} STREET ELEMENTARY - 1380801".
Select comment(s) in drop down box on the right hand column for each subject, as needed.	Input your achievement (AC) and effort (EF) grades for each subject for that particular student.	Select "Term Code(s)" drop down menu. Click on 2014 - 2015 A-Track Elementary - Elementary - Single Track A".
Scroll all the way down, click "Submit". Grades will only be saved once you click "Submit", so DON'T FORGET!	Input comments by subject on the right hand side, as needed.	Select "Subject Category" drop down menu. Click on whatever report you are trying to print: Academic Subjects, Learning and Social Skills, or Work and Study Habits.
	Scroll all the way down, click "Submit". Grades will only be saved once you click "Submit", so DON'T FORGET!	In the top right hand corner, click on "View Report".
		After the document loads, click on the save icon (blue disk with a green arrow), and select "PDF".
		Repeat the process above for the remaining two verification reports.
